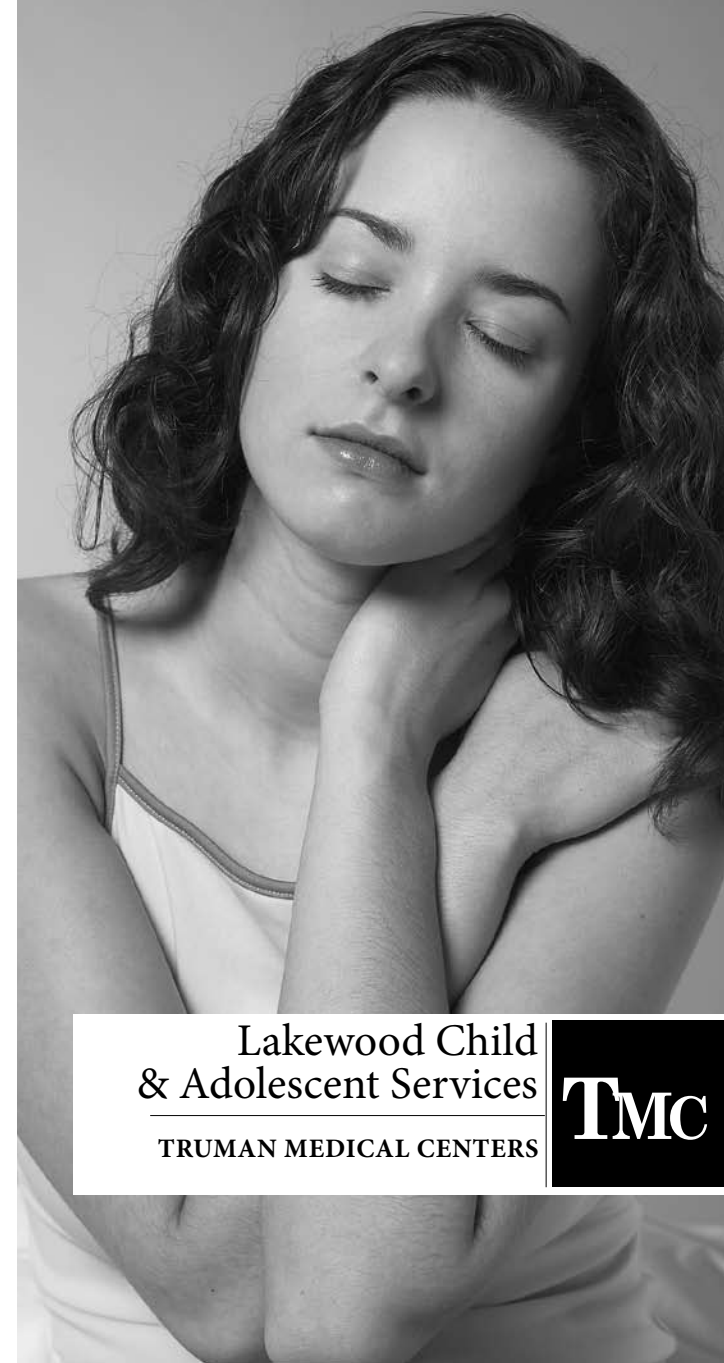
Truman Medical Center Behavioral Health provides services in downtown Kansas City, Missouri and Eastern Jackson County.

LCS Support Services for Children, Adolescents and Their Families



It is often easy to identify a child's physical needs, however, a child's mental and emotional needs may not be as obvious.

Good mental health allows children to think clearly and develop self confidence, self-esteem, and a healthy emotional outlook on life.

Parents, family members, teachers and other caregivers are usually the first to notice if a child has emotional problems. The following are signs that a child may need emotional support:

- decline in school performance
- poor grades despite strong efforts
- excessive worry or anxiety
- repeated refusal to go to school or take part in typical children's activities
- hyperactivity or fidgeting
- frequent nightmares
- consistently breaks the rules or shows violent behavior
- frequent temper tantrums
- depression, sadness or irritability
- cutting and other forms of self harm

Lakewood Counseling Service Child and Adolescent Support Services provides outpatient behavioral health care to children, youth and families.

Services

Intake Screenings

Both the child and family are evaluated to determine the need for services. After a review of the child's physical and mental health, school performance, family situation and behaviors a treatment plan is developed.

To schedule an assessment, please call (816)404-6170. The child's guardian must accompany them, and bring the child's social security card, birth certificate, insurance card and immunization records to be copied.

Medication Services

This service is for children and adolescents who might benefit from medication. Services are available Monday - Thursday. A psychiatrist prescribes, monitors and educates parents and children about the medication they are taking.

Individual Family and Group Therapy

Individual therapy helps the child maximize strengths and reduce behavioral problems. Family therapy helps to achieve goals related to improving the client's total psychological functioning.



Diagnosis

Most children who receive services have the following diagnoses:

- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Oppositional Defiant Disorder
- Mood Disorders (Depression, Bipolar Disorder)
- Anxiety Disorders (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder, Separation Anxiety, Generalized)
